Connecticut occupational therapists are invited to participate in **no-cost training** for two evidence-informed programs, funded through the **American Rescue Plan Section 9817 (ARP)**.

All training must be completed by September 30, 2025.

PROGRAM 1: COPE—Care of Older People in their Environment

COPE is a strengths-based, person-centered program that improves quality of life for people living with dementia and their caregivers.

What You'll Learn:

- How to reduce environmental stressors
- How to support function in daily life
- How to build caregiver confidence & problemsolving skills

Training Format:

- 10 self-paced online modules
- 1 live virtual session with program developers

PROGRAM 2: Confident Caregiver (Available after completing COPE)

Designed for caregivers of older adults living with serious or chronic illness **without** cognitive impairment.

What You'll Learn:

- Practical strategies & disease education
- Emotional support & referral guidance
- Caregiver self-care techniques

Training Format:

- 6 self-paced modules
- 1 group virtual discussion

NEW! Expanded Eligibility

You **do not need** to be contracted with a Home Health Agency (HHA) to start. **Individual occupational therapists may now complete training in advance** and become more competitive for future contracts.
